### **METHODS AND TOOLS**

#### 1. INCO MOLFETTA - MENTORSHIP

LOCAL YOUNG PEOPLE ARE ENGAGED THROUGH THE MENTORSHIP OF INTERNATIONAL VOLUNTEERS (PERSONAL SUPPORT, FRIENDSHIPS, REFLECTIONS, PROBLEM SOLVING); THE ASSOCIATION IS BUILDING A COMMUNITY OF MENTORS THROUGH INFORMAL MEETINGS, IN WHICH THEY CAN SHARE THEIR EXPERIENCES AND CONNECT WITH OTHER LOCALS; INCO PROVIDES TRAININGS FOR MENTORS (PREPARATION, MID-TERM EVALUATION AND FINAL EVALUATION); A CERTIFICATE IS PROVIDED AT THE END OF THE SERVICE, SO THERE WOULD BE ALSO A SENSE OF ACHIEVEMENT; MENTORS ARE ALWAYS INVITED IN ALL THE EVENTS RELATED TO THE ESC AND NOT ONLY.

#### 2. CENTAR ZA MLADE"ALARM" PAZIN

WORLD CAFE - A METHOD WHICH HELPS TO SIMULATE THE DIALOGUE BETWEEN THE YOUTH, POLICY MAKERS AND DECISION MAKERS IN A SMALL COMMUNITY. EACH OF THE PARTICIPANT HAS A CERTAIN ROLE: YOUTH WORKERS, YOUNG PEOPLE, MAYORS, MUNICIPALITY EMPLOYEES. THE PURPOSE OF THE METHOD IS TO UNDERSTAND BETTER YOUTH POLICIES, THE ROLES OF DIFFERENT PARTIES AND RESPONSIBLE PEOPLE IN THE YOUTH POLICY MAKING, AS WELL AS THE NEEDS OF THE YOUTH, THE RESULT: A STRUCTURED DIALOGUE.



# BEST PRACTICES METHODS AND TOOLS

#### **3. AYUNTAMIENTO DE ALTEA**

A) THE VOLUNTEERS MAKE WORKSHOPS AND THE MUNICIPALITY PROVIDES THE MATERIAL THEY NEED. FOR EXAMPLE, COOKING WORKSHOP - THE PURPOSE OF IT IS TO MAKE CONNECTIONS BETWEEN YOUNG PEOPLE AND SENIORS (TO REDUCE GENERATIONAL GAPS).

B) EACH NATIONAL GROUP HAS A PICTURE OF THEIR NATIONAL DISH AND THEY PRESENT IT TO THE OTHERS. THE IDEA IS TO GET TO KNOW THE CULTURES THROUGH THEIR CUISINE AND CONNECT PEOPLE WITH THE HELP OF FOOD. AT THE END, THE PARTICIPANTS ARE INVITED TO REFLECT ON WHAT DID THEY LEARN ABOUT OTHER COUNTRIES.

#### **4. AYUNTAMIENTO DE ALZIRA**

A) STORYTELLING - TO INSPIRE YOUNG PEOPLE.

B) EMPLOYMENT COACHING IS USED TO INCREASE THE EMPLOYMENT OF THE YOUTH WITH THE HELP OF NON-FORMAL TRAININGS AND COLLABORATION WITH THE POSSIBLE EMPLOYERS.

C) SOCIAL INCLUSION - MUNICIPALITY PROVIDES OPPORTUNITIES TO THE YOUNGSTERS WITH FEWER OPPORTUNITIES IN ORDER FOR THEM TO GAIN NEW SKILLS (DIFFERENT TYPES OF WORKSHOPS AND NON-FORMAL ACTIVITIES).



# **BEST PRACTICES** METHODS AND TOOLS

#### **5. COMUNE DI MOLFETTA**

A) MUNICIPALITY WITH THE HELP OF LOCAL PROJECT PROVIDES EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE DISABLED PEOPLE. SOCIAL WORKERS PARTICIPATE IN THE PROJECT AND PROVIDE SUPPORT TO THE FAMILIES.

**B) MUNICIPALITY HOSTS THE ESC VOLUNTEERS -**

C) MUNICIPALITY COLLABORATES WITH THE NON-PROFITS IN THE LOCAL AREA THROUGH DIFFERENT PROJECTS, ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS.

D) URBAN GARDEN IN WHICH DIFFERENT NGOS AND LOCAL PEOPLE CAN CULTIVATE VEGETABLES. THE PURPOSE: LOCAL PEOPLE AND LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS LEARN ABOUT AGRICULTUR; IT SERVES AS A TOOL TO REDUCE GENERATIONAL GAPS, PROMOTE SUSTAINABLE AND ECOLOGICAL WAY OF LIVING, CONNECT LOCALS AND INTERNATIONAL YOUNG PEOPLE, EMBRACE SOCIAL INCLUSION.

#### 6. UDHETIM I LIRE/ LIBERI DI VIAGGIARE

PANDEMIC EXPERIENCE MADE A SHIFT INTO DIGITAL ACTIVITIES FOR THE YOUTH. E.G. ONLINE QUIZES ON INSTAGRAM ABOUT RELEVANT TOPICS (GENDER EQUALITY, HATE SPEECH, CYBER BULLYING). THESE TYPE OF ACTIVITIES HELP TO DEVELOP DIGITAL SKILLS, THEY ARE BOTH INFORMATIVE AND FUN.







# **BEST PRACTICES** METHODS AND TOOLS

#### 7. MEETINGPOINT MUSIC MESSIAEN E.V.

PRESENTATION OF DIFFICULT HISTORICAL TOPICS (SUCH AS WAR) WITH THE HELP OF PERMFORMING ARTS (THEATRE, CIRCUS, ETC.) IN ORDER TO INFORM YOUNG PEOPLE IN AN ENTERTAINING WAY AND RAISE AWARENESS,

#### 8. YOUTHFULLY YOURS

THE IMPORTANCE OF SELF-ESTEEM OF THE YOUNG PEOPLE. NON-FORMAL ACTIVITIES WHICH HELP THE YOUTH TO BE MORE CONSCIOUS ON THEIR SELF CRITICISM (E.G. WRITING ON PEOPLE'S BACKS THE THINGS THAT YOU LIKE ABOUT THEM IN ORDER FOR THEM TO CONCENTRATE MORE ON THE POSITIVE SIDES OF THEIR CHARACTER),

#### 9. MUNICIPALITY OF SEVLIEVO

SUPPORTING YOUNG PEOPLE IN THE REFLECTION ON SELF-UNDERSTANDING, SELF-ESTEEM AND THE AREAS OF IMPROVEMENT. THE METHOD OF DRAWING A CIRCLE (ASK SIMPLY TO A YOUNG PERSON 'WHAT DO YOU LIKE/DON'T LIKE ABOUT YOURSELF?') WHICH INVITES TO RECONSIDER THAT EACH PERSON HAS STRENGTHS AND AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT. THIS METHOD CAN SERVE AS A STARTING POINT TO CONNECT WITH A YOUNG PERSON AND SETTING HIS/HER GOALS (WHILE ADDRESSING THE SKILLS THE YOUNG PERSON WANT TO IMPROVE).



### **BEST PRACTICES**

### YOUTH WORK AND FEWER OPPORTUNITIES

- DISABILITY TAKING THE YOUNG PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES (PHYSICAL OBSTACLES) OUTSIDE IN THE SUMMER: THEY GO WITH THE VOLUNTEERS TO ENJOY THE NATURE; THE METHOD IN WHICH BLINDFOLDS ARE (THEY NEED TO DESCRIBE THE SURROUNDINGS) USED IN ORDER TO EMPATHIZE WITH THE VISUALLY IMPAIRED PARTICIPANTS OF THE PROJECT.
- HEALTH ISSUES REDNOSE INITIATIVE (THE VOLUNTEERS GO TO PLAY WITH THE CHILDREN WITH SEVERE ILLNESSES);
- EDUCATIONAL DIFFICULTIES NON-FORMAL AND INFORMAL METHODS AND ACTIVITIES; WORKSHOPS ON COMMUNICATION, NON-FORMAL TRAININGS (E.G. COOKING CLASS);
- ECONOMIC OBSTACLES FINANCIAL SUPPORT FROM THE NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS, DONATIONS, CROWD-FUNDING; OPPORTUNITIES WITH SOCIAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP;
- SOCIAL OBSTACLES HUMAN LIBRARY (DISCUSSION ABOUT THE BOOKS AMONG PEOPLE WHO HAVE STEREOTYPES ABOUT MINORITIES, REFUGEES, EX-DRUG ADDICTS, ETC. THEY TELL THEIR STORIES TO THE LOCALS);







### **BEST PRACTICES**

### YOUTH WORK AND FEWER OPPORTUNITIES

- GEOGRAPHICAL OBSTACLES TO INVOLVE PARTICIPANTS FROM RURAL AREAS TO THE YOUTH EXCHANGES AND THE ESC.
- VARIOUS OBSTACLES ASSISTANCE IN EMPLOYMENT AND GUIDE IN THE CARREER (ALSO, WITH THE HELP OF MOBILITY PROJECTS); PROVIDING VET AND OTHER RELATED COURSES; SUPPORT IN THE IMPROVEMENT OF SOFT AND HARD SKILLS OF YOUNG PEOPLE.

IT WAS CONCLUDED THAT SUPPORT HAS TO BE PROVIDED ON ALL THE LEVELS OF THE STRUCTURE (POLICY MAKERS, GOVERNMENT, PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION). IT WAS ALSO AGREED THAT LOCAL YOUTH HAS TO BE INFORMED BETTER ABOUT THE OPPORTUNITIES (LOCALLY AND INTERNATIONALLY) OFFERED BY THE MUNICIPALITIES, YOUTH CENTERS AND LOCAL NGOS. IN ADDITION, IT IS IMPORTANT TO BE ABLE TO MAP THE NEEDS OF YOUNG PEOPLE IN A LOCAL COMMUNITY AND CORRESPOND TO THOSE NEEDS, SO YOUNG PEOPLE WOULD REACH OUT TO THE SUPPORT AND GUIDANCE FROM YOUTH WORKERS IN MUNICIPALITIES.



# MAPPING THE NEEDS OF YOUNG PEOPLE IN A LOCAL COMMUNITY

### **THE NEEDS:**

SUPPORT, OPPORTUNITIES, UNDERSTANDING, ACTIVE LISTENING, TRANSPARENT COMMUNICATION, TRUST, RESPONSIBILITY, INVOLVEMENT IN DECISION-MAKING, ORIENTATION AND GUIDANCE, DEVELOPMENT, A STRUCTURED YOUTH POLICY, MOTIVATION.

### **SUPPORT:**

LOCAL AND EU PROJECTS, WORKSHOPS, ROUNDTABLES WITH BENEFICIARIES, NON-FORMAL EDUCATION AND ENGAGEMENT; INTERACTIVE WAYS OF ENGAGING WITH YOUNG PEOPLE; FINANCIAL SUPPORT; SKILLS, YOUTH WORKERS; KNOWLEDGE; NON-FORMAL EDUCATION IN A FORMAL LEARNING ENVIRONMENT; RECOGNITION; CO-CREATION AND COLLABORATION (INVOLVEMENT OF YOUNG PEOPLE IN DECISION-MAKING).

### **EFFECTS**:

A BETTER SOCIETY; ACTIVE AND MEANINGFUL YOUTH PARTICIPATION; NO GAPS (GENERATIONAL, CULTURAL, GENDER, AGE...); STAYING/RETURNING TO YOUR HOMETOWN (CONTRIBUTION TO YOUR OWN COMMUNITY); INDEPENDENT YOUNG PEOPLE; BETTER QUALITY OF LIFE.







# MAPPING THE NEEDS OF YOUNG PEOPLE IN A LOCAL COMMUNITY

#### **THE NEEDS:**

BEING LISTENED TO; SENSE OF BELONGING; VALIDATION; SOCIAL INCLUSION; ASSISTANCE IN CHOOSING THE RIGHT DIRECTION; SELF-AWARENESS OF ONE'S STRENGTHS AND AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT.

### **SUPPORT:**

GROUP DISCUSSION; ACTIVE LISTENING; MENTORSHIP; SHARING EXPERIENCE WITH THEIR PEERS; NOT TO BE JUDGED (BEING ACCEPTED); GROUP ACTIVITIES; OPPORTUNITIES; TO PROVIDE A SENSE OF BELONGING; COURSES AND TRAINING; AFTER SCHOOL GUIDANCE; ROLE MODEL; INVOLVEMENT IN DECISION-MAKING.

### **EFFECTS**:

CONNECTION WITH NATURE AND OTHER PEOPLE OF A LOCAL COMMUNITY; RELIABLE YOUNG PEOPLE; INCLUSION AND A SENSE OF BELONGING - PEOPLE DO NOT FEEL LONELY.
